Topics being considered by the Program Committee include mass disasters, alcohol-related deaths, sports and recreation-related deaths and cardiac-related deaths.

The IACME Banquet will take place Friday evening following a cocktail reception for attendees. The evening will include a presentation on stress in death investigators, a topic of interest to IACME members and their spouses. Programming on Saturday, November 5 will conclude before noon.
